AQUAPOL currently counts **26 law enforcement authorities** (members, observers and a partner) from **19 countries**.

The network is organized in **4 hubs**, each covering a specific geographical zone. Each hub is chaired by a member.

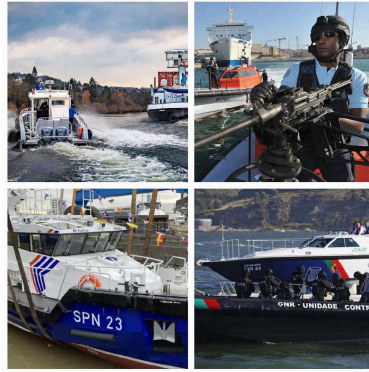

OUR MAIN MISSIONS

Inland and maritime transport in Europe is fully liberalized and overwhelmingly operates across borders. In contrast, law enforcement authorities remain organized at national level.

In the context, cooperation among national law enforcement authorities is essential to ensure effective safety and security of water transport.

Such is the main mission of AQUAPOL : to develop cooperation and to build a common culture of security among its members.

To that end, AQUAPOL organizes activities around the following three pillars :

1. Information sharing :

- through various thematic working groups, covering labor exploitation, port security or digitalization of transport.
- through the AQUATRACK electronic database, whereby members share their control results.

2. Multi-Agency Control Operations

(MACO's), carried out at the same time by all members of a hub.

3. **Regular training**, through common exercises at hub level and a biennial AQUAPOL academy for all members.

WHO WE ARE

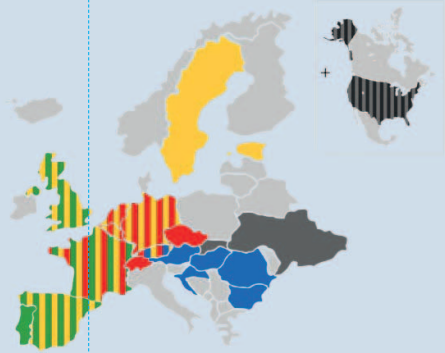


AQUAPOL is an European network of national law enforcement authorities, competent in maritime and / or inland navigation.
